Directions

Hwy 444 to Hwy 72, to 411 turn left. Hwy 411 to Shell station, exit to Hwy 360 to Hwy. 165 Tellico Plains. Good stop location - about 35 miles. Hwy 165 to Hwy 68 south, turn left Hwy 68 to Hwy 64 at Ducktown. Notes: Sharp rt. angle curves after Cocker Creek. Detour at Bridge - 50 miles R/R cross - 52 and 56 miles near Turtletown. Good stop location about 66 miles. Hwy 64 thru Ocoee River and park turn right on Hwy 30. Hwy 30 to Hwy 315 at River (Reliance) Turn right on Hwy 315, good location - 90 miles. Hwy 315 to Hwy 90. Hwy 39 to Gamble Gap Road on left, bump in road about 110 miles. Stop Sign - uphill bear left. Follow Old State North until Hwy 68 stop. Cross Hwy 68 to Big Creek Road bear right. Big Creek turn at Fairview - stop sign. Fairview to Bal Play Road - bear left. Ball Play to Hwy 411 - stop light. Hwy 411 towards Vonore - send Kahati people home. Hwy. 411 to Wayman Road at gas station turn left. Wayman to Oak Grove at top of hill - turn right. Oak Grove becomes Loudon Road at Hwy 322. Loudon to Orr Road - past Eve Mill. Turn right on Orr to Hwy 72. Hwy 72 to 444 about 140 miles. Total time 4 to 4.5 hours.
