Directions left on 72 to left on 411 to rt on 360 thru Tellico Plains to to left on 68 to (Ducktown) to 60 (Copperhill) rt on 5 st stop sign (to Blue Ridge) rt on 76 (twd Ellijay). Before Ellijay proper go left on "road to 52". Left on 52 to Amicalola State Park entrance on left. Note: If you are going to eat at The Lodge tell the park attendant at the entrance and the \$5 entrance fee will be waived. Ride to the top of the mtn for the Maple Restaurant (inside the lodge). After lunch the best place to see the falls from (with just a short walk - 3/8ths of a mike) is the West Ridge/ADA pull off (2<sup>nd</sup> left on the way back down the mtn). Exit the park rt on 52 and take it all the way to 41 IN and return to 72 and 444

Gas/Pit Stops Copperhill and Chadsworth - but many along the way

Restaurants The Maple Restaurant at The Lodge in the park - really nice buffet!

Additional Comments The falls is a 729' cascading display - largest one east of the Mississippi. Rt 52 btn Ellijay and Chadsworth over Fort Mtn has some nice curvies :-)
